



We have missed you! The doctors and staff at Tiny Teeth would like to thank you for your patience and understanding as we transition back to “normal” during the COVID-19 pandemic. Our office is open and ready to start rescheduling appointments that were postponed due to COVID-19. We’re looking forward to seeing all those smiling faces that we have missed over the past several weeks! Our team is working diligently to reschedule all missed appointments. If you have not heard from us yet, please be patient with us as we will be contacting you as soon as possible. If your child is experiencing an urgent dental concern, please call our office.

In an effort to provide the safest environment possible to our patients and team members, our office is following guidelines by the American Dental Association (ADA), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and are continually monitoring each agency for the most up to date information. To ensure our patients receive the highest quality and safest care, we have also enhanced our standard precautions regarding hand hygiene, personal protective equipment, disinfection and hospital grade instrument sterilization. Although we may look a little different than what you’re used to, please know that we are wearing the same warm smile underneath all our new gear!

To further protect our patients and team members, we have adopted new policies and added the following extended measures:

- At this time, we are limiting the number of people allowed in the building and will only be allowing one parent/guardian in the treatment areas with the child. If your child is not new to our office and is old enough and comfortable coming back by themselves, that is preferred. No other children or family members will be allowed to go back with the child and will not be permitted to stay in the waiting room due to limiting the number of people and spacing concerns. Please make other arrangements for family members that are not being treated. (Children that are scheduled for IV sedation will be allowed two adults to accompany the child for their procedure.)
- We will be calling to confirm all appointments and will pre-screen appointments with questions related to COVID-19. You will be asked those same questions upon arrival to your appointment.
- We encourage the use of masks for our patients and parents. If you have your own and would like to bring it with you, please do so. If you do not have your own mask, we are happy to provide a cloth mask for you to use in our office.
- Upon arrival at Tiny Teeth, you will be stopped in the vestibule and screened. Your temperature and your child’s temperature will be taken. Additionally, you will be asked to cleanse your hands with the provided hand sanitizer before entering the office.
- After entering the reception area, please proceed to the check in area where a member of our staff will check your child in and assign a designated seating area. If space is limited, you may be asked to return to your vehicle and will be called/texted when we are ready to seat your child.
- We have temporarily turned off all gaming systems for your child’s protection, as they are difficult to clean and sanitize.

We want your family to know that their safety is of the utmost importance to us and want to reassure you that things will get back to normal—we just have to be patient. Our team is looking forward to seeing your family soon and hope that you will contact us with any questions or concerns you may have.
